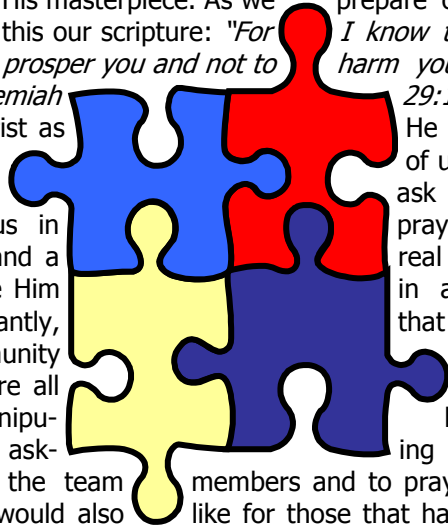

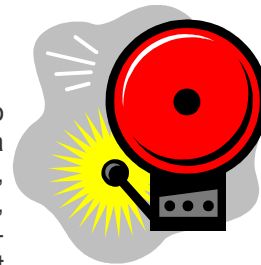
A NOTE FROM OUR LAY DIRECTOR
