From the Good Shepherd

I write this article just hours after leaving Ruggles Campground following the closing ceremony of Men's Walk #24. The opportunity to serve on these walks, or to attend the services throughout the walk are always humbling experiences for me. In fact, I sit here on a spiritual high that is, no doubt, the product of many hours spent in the presence of Christian friends. Think back to all the times you have attended an Emmaus event- be it a Gathering, Walk service, or even your original Walk. Can you think of any time when you left those events without feeling uplifted or without being refreshed in your spiritual life? Chances are your answer is no. If we agree that spending time in prayer, fellowship, and worship with Christian friends makes us feel better, why should we limit ourselves to weekly church services, once a month gatherings- or even less? Share groups allow us an opportunity to grow closer to God by meeting on a more frequent basis. They allow us to meet in a more personal environment with prayers, support and possibly some good advice from our close friends. Remember what Jesus teaches in Matthew when he explains, "For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them" (Matthew 18:20).

It is also important to remember that the potential for growth of our groups is a two way street. We encourage pilgrims to seek out a share group to join after the completion of their walk. In fact, they are reminded several times throughout their 72 hour experience and in the time following their walk. How often do we consider inviting someone to join our already established groups? Some Christians are more comfortable developing a new group to be a part of, but how do we know that some are not simply awaiting an invitation? I encourage all Emmaus members to spend some time in prayer for the growth of active share groups throughout our community. At the September 24th gathering, there will be some sheets passed around to make record of our current share groups. Some information needed will be the group's name (if it has one), general meeting location, meeting time (unless it is at random), and group member names. I would appreciate any information we can get together for the future use of our community. Have a blessed month and for those currently involved in share groups, please remember to keep Women's Walk #27 in your group prayers.
